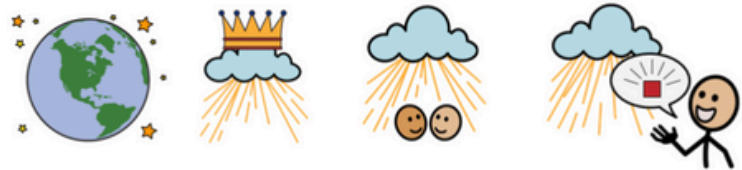
Blessed is Adonai, the Blessed One, now and forever.

Blessed are you, Adonai our God, Sovereign of the universe



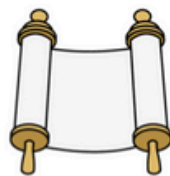
בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יי אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם

Blessed are You, Adonai, who gives us the Torah.

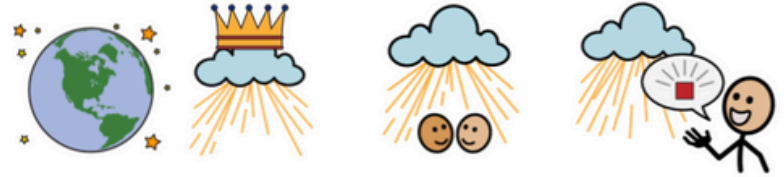

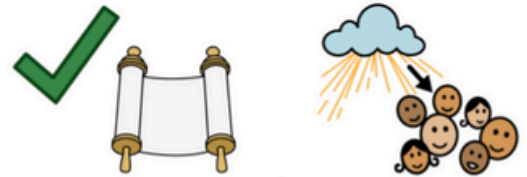

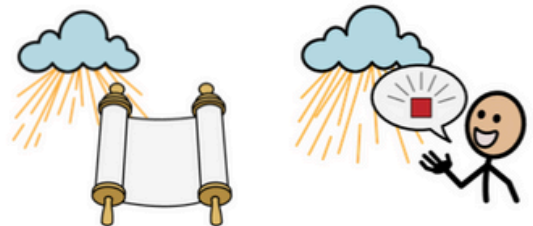
